Attached is a description of our tribal Hood Canal chinook troll fishery plan, provided in a LOAF-type format, in an effort to provide a written description containing specifics for the co-managers and also to keep you informed on the development of the fishery.

We are preparing a separate monitoring and sampling plan for this fishery, and we expect to have that out early next week. We will provide a copy to you for your information at that time.

We have worked with the WDFW and NWIFC model team to finally settle on "terminal" fishery inputs for modelling this fishery in the next round of the model (being worked on today for next week's meetings). I suspect that once we have conducted this fishery this season we will have more information and data to supplement the input question for next year's fishery.
