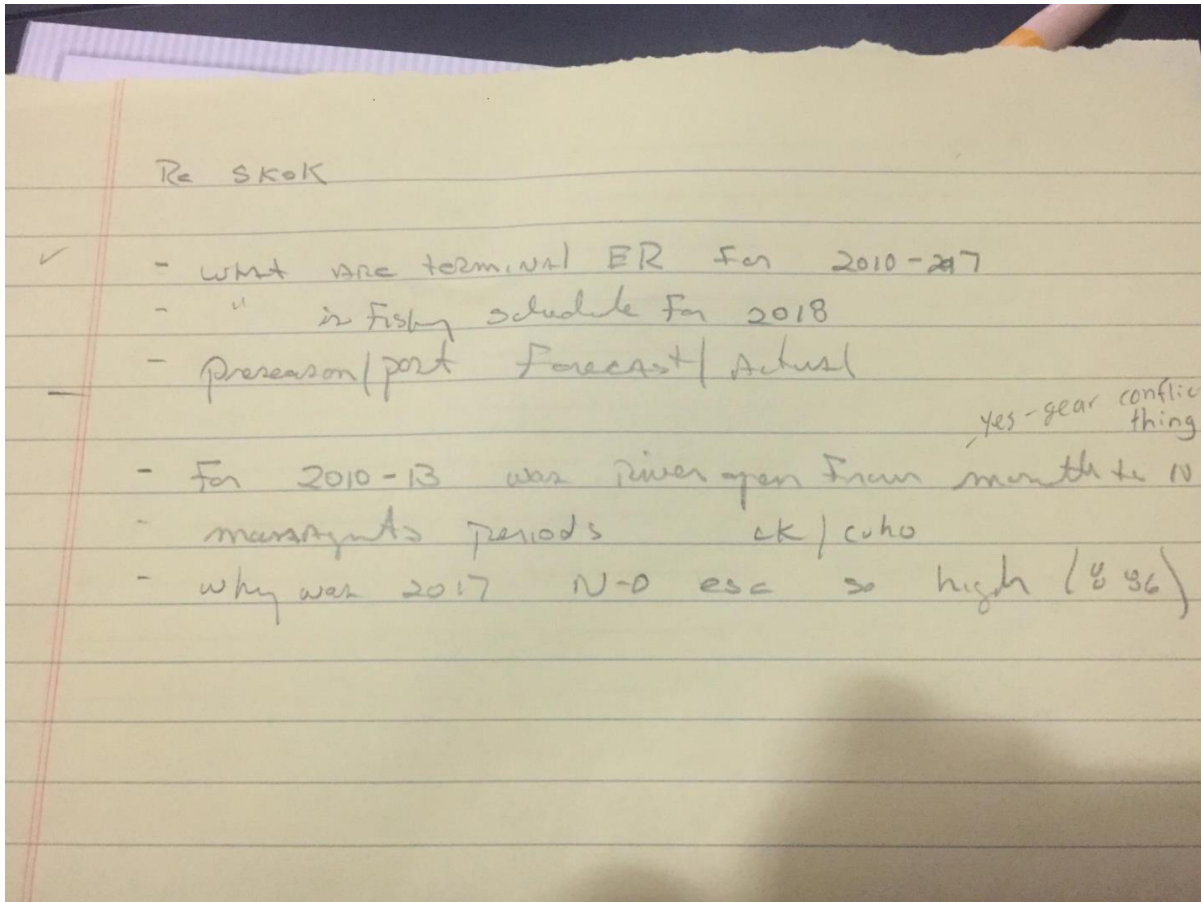
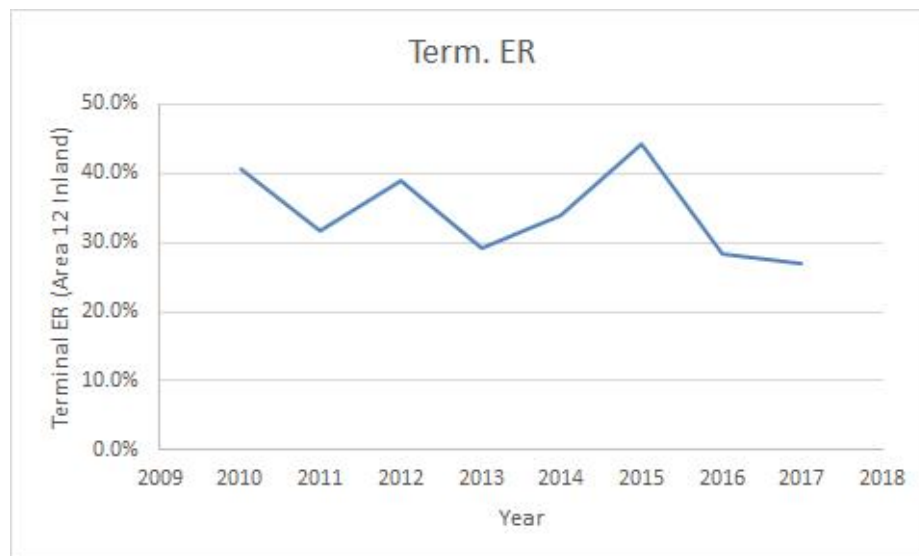

- 4) Yes the mouth to the HWY 106 bridge was open to recreational fishing 2010-2015, seven days per week. Beginning in 2012 WDFW closed the recreational fishery Mon-Thur between HWY 101 and HWY 106 when the Skokomish Tribe was open to reduce gear and fisher conflict; the mouth to HWY 106 remained open at 7d/wk for the recreational fishery. The Skokomish Tribe opened the mouth to the HWY 106 section only in 2014 and 2015.
- 5) See tribal schedule in question 2.
- 6) Unknown, but could very well be a combination of good ocean conditions, habitat actions in the Skokomish River and reduced fishing footprint (closure of the recreational fishery in 2016 and 2017 and reduced tribal fishing schedules in 2016 and 2017).
