While Barry still does not see a clear role for NOAA, as we understand the on-going issues in the Skagit, he is prepared to speak to two issues related to them.

- 1) Current tribal negotiation: That this is a harvest mgmt issue and that this is squarely in the manager's hands. Implications of non-agreement in Skagit threaten to postpone or eliminate all fishing in Puget Sound.
- 2) Alternative rate limit for 2021: Deviating from biologically based, co-manager proposed, conservation limits to fisheries, is not a prudent decision, particularly in light of the current legal outlook for this year and could undercut the PS-wide approach we utilize for balancing risks across the ESU.

If these are the issues that the Skagit co-managers are looking to discuss, then please go ahead and schedule a 3:15-4:00 for this afternoon (sorry, his schedule already got pinched). If there are other issues, please let me know before scheduling.
